

RAYMOND CENTRAL FBLA ACTIVITY POINT SYSTEM

ACTIVITY POINTS

Activity points will be based on participation in various activities and committee assignments. Points will accumulate to earn an FBLA letter each year and to qualify a member to represent the chapter at the State Leadership Conference. Activity points for the current year start accumulating on the night of the awards banquet. A minimum number of points must have been earned to participate in certain activities as specified in the standing rules.

Partnership with Business Shadowing - 25
Entrepreneur's Breakfast - 40
State Leadership Conference - 70
Run for a Local Office - 70

LETTERING REQUIREMENTS

A member must accumulate 70 activity points to earn a letter. Members must also work at the concession stand at least twice during the year and attend four monthly meetings as part of the requirements to letter. Members must meet this criteria to demonstrate active involvement in the organization. Points will be deducted from the total for failing to meet obligations or committee responsibilities.

POINT ASSIGNMENTS

Social Activities – participant in any social activity such as putt-putt golfing or volleyball night will be given 5 points.

Professional Activities – participant in professional growth activities such as the shadowing project or an area meeting will be given 10 points. Attending area meetings at other schools 15 points.

Community Service – participant will be given 5 points for an activity that lasts approximately one hour. Additional points are given for bringing cookies for senior citizens and eggs, etc., to the breakfast.

Committee Work - points will be assigned based on time. Participant will be given 5 points for each hour of committee work. This also includes report and scrapbook preparation.

Honor Roll - each quarter a member may earn the following points (Special Commendation - 10 points., Honor Roll - 5 points., Honorable. Mention - 3 points.)

Executive Officer Meetings - an officer will receive 2 points for the monthly officer meeting. They will receive 10 points for attending the officer training session.

Points will be assigned for each FBLA activity. A member completing extra projects for their individual gain such as the quality member award will not receive points for those activities.

Points will be assigned for any activity not covered in these guidelines at the discretion of the advisors and will be based on the length of the activity.

STATE LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

To represent the chapter, a member must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Earn a minimum of 70 points
2. Work at the concession stand at least twice.
3. Attend at least four monthly meetings.
4. Be in the top 40% of total chapter members based on total points (percentage set by the State Office)
5. Last date for earning points is mid-February and will be established each year. Point totals will be posted monthly.
6. In case of a tie in points, a senior has priority over a junior, etc.
7. Must attend all competitive practices for state.
8. Be a member in good standing. Since this is an overnight activity, only responsible students will be allowed to attend.
