Overview

One (1) \$500 scholarship will be presented to an outstanding FBLA senior member who is planning to attend a two-year or four-year institution next year in Nebraska. These students must become members of Nebraska PBL and have the intention of actively participating. The \$500 must be used for tuition and will be sent once the individual is a dues paid member of Nebraska PBL.

Eligibility

Each chapter may submit three applications for seniors who plan to join PBL in college.

Guidelines

- Complete the Scholarship Application.
- Submit a one-page essay stating why the applicant plans to further his/her education in business, how he/she plans to be involved in Nebraska Professional Business Leaders (PBL), and what he/she will bring to Nebraska PBL. Essays for the scholarship must include the applicant's name and chapter at the top of the first page.
- Submit one letter of recommendation.
- Submit all information together in one email.
