Objective Testing Instructions - Students

Student Onsite Instructions:

- Enter through the main entrance (south doors) at Younes Conference Center – South
- 2. Check in at the registration desk at Diamond Ballrooms 1/6
 - a. Check-in will need to happen for each test.
 - b. You will need your <u>name badge</u> for testing!
- 3. Enter testing holding room.
- 4. Event staff/advisers will notify you when you may enter the testing rooms.
- 5. Enter quietly, staff will direct you to seat.
- 6. Set up computer and begin testing.
- 7. Once you are finished with your test, you will show the final test summited. screen to the facilitator by the exit door.

Students should arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the assigned testing time.

To avoid conflicts with presentation or testing events, we have added a standby option. You will be able to join the standby line during the times listed below if you are not able to make it during the assigned time <u>due to competitive event conflicts only</u>.

All students will be given the full-time. With 30 minutes left in the scheduled day, no additional students will be allowed in for testing. Check in will close 30 minutes after the last test has begun.

As chairs become available, students will be let in from the holding room to take their test.

Please remember to stay quiet in the holding room while waiting and enter the testing rooms quietly as other students may be finishing their tests.

Students will need to bring with them a <u>charged</u> device (laptop or tablet) for testing. No charging stations will be available inside the testing rooms.
