- The applicant must submit a 500-word essay stating why he/she plans to further his/her education in business, why he/she is qualified, and his/her life goals.
- Essays for the scholarship must include the applicant's name and chapter at the top of the first page.
- The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation.
- A grade transcript including ACT scores must also be submitted.
- All materials must be submitted together in one packet; do not submit information in binders or folders.
